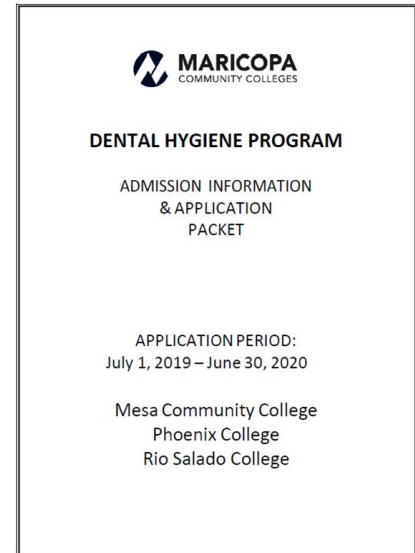

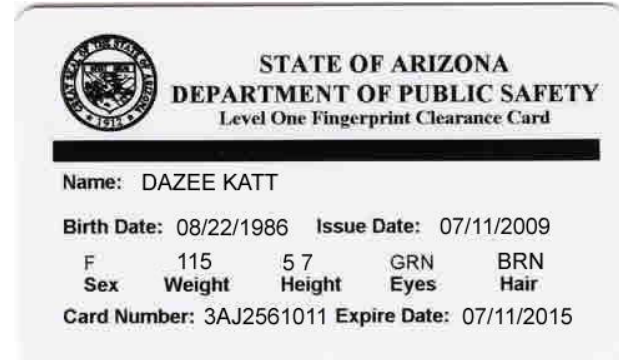

- Applications are accepted year-round at Mesa Community College, Red Mountain campus



# The Wait List

- Approximately a two to three year wait
- Students may apply for all three Maricopa Community College District Dental Hygiene Programs with one application (students select order of preference)
- **Once on the list, you will be guaranteed a spot in a program!**



# What Is The Program Like?

- The program consists of four traditional semesters, with one online class in the summer, between the traditional semesters
- Each semester requires a combination of lectures (RM campus) and clinical experiences (A.T. Still University)
