
# 4 Ways to Find Non-English Speaking Job Opportunities




#### 1. Job Search Platforms

- Google Search: Type keywords or phrases in desired language and type "Jobs" OR "Jobs near me". Toggle new job alerts if interested in being alerted for new positions
- **Indeed:** Type keywords like "Non-English" OR type desired language. *Example "Spanish"*.
- Craigslist: Use with caution, look for any red flags
- Check Local Newspapers

## 2. Reach out to Non-Profit Organizations

There are a few non-profit organizations that help refugees or community members to search jobs.

- Chicano Por La Causa (Phoenix, AZ)
- Workforce Center at Mesa (not specific to Non-English speaking)
- IRC (Only for refugees- Glendale, AZ)
- Friendly House (Phoenix, AZ)





### 3. Networking

- Ask around local business that cater to populations that use desired language.
- Communicate with Community Centers and local churches. They often have job boards and connections
- Look within your friends and family. They might have a friend of a friend with job opportunities.

### 4. Improve Basic English Skills

Improving one's English can open up more job opportunities.

- ESL Classes: offered at community colleges,
  Arizona At Work, public schools, and other non-profit orgs for free or low-cost
- Online Resources: Duolingo, Memrise, Busuu, etc.
